

〈我要向你說聲謝謝〉



今天,我看到我的數學書本,我聯想到我的哥哥教我做功課的事情。


我的哥哥長得高大,玉樹臨風,有著強大的氣場及過人的魅力,看起來就像一表人才呢!





恆心亦是成功必不可少的一項,朱光亞在二十世紀五十年代初國家任命為中國核武器研制技術創造人。當時,中國科技發展落後,製造核武器更是難上加難。但是,在他有恆心的堅持下,他帶領一批中國先進知識分子投入到原子彈研究中。直至一九六四年,一朵黃褐色的「蘑菇雲」在西北戈壁騰空而起,他這恆心的堅持了幾十年,於是他成功研發了原子彈震驚了全世界。

那麼沒有恆心又帶來甚麼?是失敗,是失敗後不敢挑戰,而連成功的機會都沒有。例如西楚霸王項羽烏江自刎。如果當時項羽肯渡河的話,留得實力還有與劉邦戰鬥的機會。他當初是何等英雄,後來卻因一次慘敗而沒有堅持到最後,不肯捲土重來,最終失敗。跟他相反的例子是勾踐,因為堅持有恆心而稱霸。

沒有恆心就不會堅持努力,就算天賦也會一事無成。北宋政治文學家王安石所寫過一篇文章,主要講述方仲永在小時候非常會寫的,寫的詩句獲得了家人與各百姓的認同,無論怎樣的題目,他都可以出口成章,可是後來他用「神童」這個稱號到處賺錢,完全沒有心思好好練習過,到他二十歲的他的才華全部消失了,一個「天才少年」,就淪落成一個平庸之輩,甚至連普通人都不如,因為他連恆心都沒有。

以上的這些例子都証實了有恆心就能成功;成功必須要有恆心,才可以令事情達到完滿,通過堅持恆心不斷進步,我們必會贏得榮譽,贏得成功;沒有恆心停止前進,總會有被歲月遺棄的一天。有恆心是萬事開頭的第一步,也是邁向成功的第一步,恆心與成功是息息相關,不可分離的,於是我認同有恆心就能成功。

有人說「有恆心就能成功的。」我同意這個看法。牛頓說過:「一個人做事若果沒有恆心,他是任何事也做不成功的。」在如今社會,成就一番大事業,若沒有恆心,那是不可能的,馬克思寫《資本論》花了 40 年,列夫·托尔斯泰寫《戰爭與和平》花了 40 年,列夫·托尔斯泰寫《戰爭與和平》花費了 37 年。只要有恆心經歷千辛萬苦就像一束曙光照耀着你,得到自己所想的。

有恆心就可以實現自己的目標和夢想。例如愛迪生發明電燈,成為了人們歷史上劃時代的偉大發明,實現了自己的人生價值,其中也有人痛苦的經歷,愛迪生在發明電燈泡時經歷的無數次失敗,愛迪生一生只上過三個月小學,被人認為他是低能,學問靠母親的教導而來,每天在實驗室發明燈泡,光蒐集資料就用了200本筆記本,為了找到合適的燈絲,先後用過銅絲、不斷的積累經驗,最終找到了最好的等死材料。表現了愛迪生的恆心,利用失敗來得到經驗,其中的有恆心為它的目的設下了基礎,最後成就了作品,人要有目標堅持不懈,最終走向成功。

有恆心就能成功,恆心是必不可少的,有恆心地追求,可達到成功,而無恆心的人做事半途而廢,總靠着運氣來過日子,做不出驚人的事情,有恆心得來的本領和無恆心所以的一事無成,一個人走向人生巔峰,一個只會平凡過一生,無法實現自己的人生價值,這樣的人生值得嗎?有恆心以及追求,便有了動力,讓自己的人生變得精彩活力。

獎賞是教育的恩物,我認為獎賞對教育有好有壞,但獎賞的好處多於壞處,我同意獎賞是教育的恩物,對孩子的成長也有積極的作用。

在西方都主張獎勵與讚賞並施的教育,以獎勵的方式,令子女、學生明白道理, 吸收知識,而成功的例子德國科學家,諾貝爾獎得主奧比海因里希·瓦伯格他的父 親也是一名科學家,他樂於傾聽奧比的感受,不時給予奧比表揚和讚賞,這激發了 奧比對科學的興趣,而獎賞可以激發孩子的學習興趣,發覺孩子潛能,獎賞也可以 激勵人們前進,相反,古話說「嚴師出高徒,棒下出孝子。」雖然可以讓孩子成長 但物極必反,在如今的東方大多數以打罵來教育孩子,而當孩子成績考得好時,只 會說不要驕傲,而不是誇讚孩子。在打罵下生活的孩子只會感到厭惡,從而討厭父 母,不想上學,離家出走,使孩子的自信心下降。孩子其實只需一句誇讚就會很開 心,以獎勵的方式,更能讓子女、學生明白道理。

獎賞能讓學生、子女有更清晰的人生目標,推動子女,學生進步。老師在學生 考試考好進步了,每天不遲到,堅持交功課,給學生們小禮物,令學生將那次優秀 的行為銘記於心,讓學生感到自己的努力被認可了。獎賞是好的教育中不可缺少的 一部分,能夠推動教育的成功。

曾有人做過一個測試,一組學生天天都對他們說:「你們做得好,十分不錯,繼續加油。」而另一組學生天天對他們說:「你們根本甚麼都做不好,做了也不成功。」一個月後,第一組天天被誇的學生,成績都在進步,而第二組天天被罵的學生,成績都有在下降。這可以說明了獎賞能讓學生自信心上升,對自己的要求上升。而被罵的學生,自信心下降。他對自己沒有要求了。獎賞能讓學生保持好成績,成績優異的同學大多能保持傑出的表現,而成績不理想的同學沒有人給他們動力讓他們前進。一個成功的教育者,對學生獎賞是需要的。

但過多的獎賞只會讓子女、學生迷失自我,一心想著獎勵,雖然獎賞也一些壞處,但獎賞時一定有助於教育的恩物,只有能把獎賞和教育運用得好,對孩子的成長會十分有利,讓孩子提前認識努力會得到回報的道理。

挫折可以阻礙人成功,也能幫助人成功。挫折的本身其實並沒有甚麼好壞之分, 不過是在解決某些問題時失敗了罷了。當然,有些問題很小,只是對個人有影響; 有些問題又很大,影響整個社會的進步。今天,我就「挫折」來談談我對它的看法。

有人說挫折會阻礙人成功。畢加索的畫,在他還健在的時候幾乎無人問津,當時的他,過著窮困潦倒的生活。自己的心血之作,卻無人問津,這對當時是畫家的他,難道不是一種否定嗎?在他後期的作品也沒早期的那種朝氣了,可見畫家對於自己的畫賣不出去是個很大的打擊,也是他遇到的挫折。畫在他死後出名,對他本人而言又有何意義呢?

挫折,只不過是向問題發出挑戰後,失敗了的後果,對於畢加索在生前的失敗, 只不過是他當時的畫不符合當時的市場需求罷了。但畢加索有向社會低頭嗎?並沒 有,他在自己的路上越走越遠,每一次作品都可以是看作他發出的挑戰,但直至他 倒下,他都沒有看見屬於他自己的勝利,對於他來說,這些挫折的確阻礙了他的成 功,在生前幾乎毫無名氣。但這使他放棄了嗎?並沒有,即使是獨自一人,他仍堅 持自己所開闢的道路。


有人說挫折能幫助人成功。瓦特因改良蒸汽機而出名,其重大意義是推動人類 文明由石器時代進入蒸汽時代的重要組成部分,在物理上專門有一個功率的單位以 他命名,即現在的功率 W=瓦特是以他命名的。由此可見瓦特做出的貢獻何其龐大。 但他沒出名前又經歷了甚麼呢?在瓦特的年代,蒸汽機已經出現但因為種種限制難 以廣泛在生活中使用。瓦特因而向改良蒸汽機發起了挑戰,在改良過程中,第一個 支持他改良蒸汽機的資金老闆被搞到破產,由此可見改良消耗大量的人力、物力和 資金。但瓦特沒有放棄,而是繼續找投資者。但第二個投資者也被破產,瓦特仍不 放棄,繼續找人和研究.....在他多次的失敗和多次不放棄的研究下,最終改良蒸汽 機成功,推動了社會的生產力,人類邁進蒸汽時代。

挫折,並沒有使這個科學家失敗,在數不清的挫折中,他克服了所有的問題,一舉震驚了世界。挫折,可以讓他看見改良蒸汽機中的漏洞,讓他下一次更加完善。挫折,是一個結果,失敗是暫時的,發現並解決其中的問題,便是挫折給我們的提示。但這並不能代表挫折能幫助人成功,挫折只是一個結果,這結果可以反映目前自己有何處的不足。但能不能發現,因人而異,能不能解決,得靠自己努力,因此挫折不能幫助人成功。

有人說克服挫折需要勇氣。挫折是一個問題所反映出來的。現代著名的物理學家霍金先生,在他發現自己有漸凍症時便一直嘗試克服,但最終無法改變,仍是變成了一個只有頭部和手指微微活動的半植物人,但即使是這樣,他利用當時最先進的輪椅,仍努力鑽研物理,最終完成了時間簡史,他對黑洞等理解給物理學界留下了巨大的貢獻,

挑戰問題,本身便需要挑戰的勇氣,更何況是挫折,是問題之後的另一種呈現。 霍金他本身的問題對於他難道不是一個一生挫折?但他最終通過自身的努力,克服 了心理和學習方面的問題,仍在物理學上開拓土地,成就了他自己的一生。克服挫 折需要有比面對問題更多的勇氣和韌性,克服不只是講其勇氣,韌性也十分之關鍵。 如果不能堅持不懈,霍金如何有今日之成就?

古有在牢中完成史學巨作《史記》之司馬遷,今有在與發明大王愛迪生競爭中 突破思想籠牢發明比直流電更安全的交流電的特斯拉。在眾多歷史上出現的種種人 物,他們更多都有著其獨特的人格魅力和發現並解決問題的勇氣和韌性。他們所經 歷的挫折不會少,有人失敗了,名留青史,有人成功了,卻遺臭萬年。成功的定義 又是永遠被後世推翻的,但做到了克服所面對問題的努力,擊敗了自己所面對的挫 折,不管被定義為成功或失敗,我相信他們已問心無愧,這些人都是我敬佩和值得 我學習的對象。挫折本身,本不應被懼怕!它僅僅只是遇到的問題對於人的另一種 呈現方式。



俗語說:「人善被人欺,馬善被人騎。」說這句話的人想必是親身體會過善良之人的下場吧。孟子主張「性本善」,認為人出生便是善良,因後天因素變為惡人。擁有大智慧的人會善用善良,建立人際關係等等......但若善良是出於目的,便是偽善。人們最不恥偽善者,人們最不齒為善者。認為偽君子比真小人更為可恥,因此如何有智慧的善良是愚者和善者的界限。

很多人常常抱怨道:「善良只會讓人吃虧罷了。」我想這是他們不願意善良的藉口,他們放眼於自身的利益,卻無視別人日常對他的善,若然認為別人的善是理所當然,那麼便會馬上狠狠的打了自己一大嘴巴。只因沒有人會理所當然的吃虧。 人們總是無視別人付出的善,這樣他們即使不善,也變得理直氣壯。這樣其實比愚善來得差劣,但那正正是大多人傾向的態度。

凡事也有例外,有天一個人因善良受盡傷害,弄得自己不再對善抱有希望。想必我會同情和理解他,並暗自痛斥那些傷害他的人,因此我對上有不同的見解。不應對所有人都善,反而是要仔細思考對方是否合適。因為惡人可是聽不進去你的善,真正道德敗壞的人很難透過善這種方式勸說他們,與其浪費時間對牛彈琴,倒不如用適當方法對待適當的人,以刑罰對待作奸犯科者,以禮對待品格善良者,善惡分明是,恩威並施,這不就是從古到今一直沿用的方法嗎?

這樣有智慧地善,不但能使善者不受傷害,還能使人們以善報善,主張行善風氣,簡直是一舉兩得。

善良是智慧的表現,吳國的魯肅可說是大智若愚,我認為他是最能將善良與智慧並重的智者。魯肅家境富裕,早年就曾借給周瑜大量物質,協助他渡過難關,協助他渡過難關。相信大家只記得諸葛亮的隆中對,卻嫌少,聽過魯肅的塌上策,但我認為蜀漢的成功少不了東吳的支持,魯肅常被後世的人取笑太善良,被諸葛亮予取予求,但他的塌上策及他的善良卻是在我看來最有遠見的,他多次支持和蜀國合作,也疲於奔命的在兩國進行外交遊說,最終兩國合作成功在赤壁之戰大敗北方的魏,這場經典以弱勝強缺少任何一方都將失敗,可見其遠見。之後更是提議將荊州所有權暫借劉備,協助蜀發展,但他不但想到了這層,還提出相屬租借土地不僅能提高兩國外交關係,還能使其為自己對抗魏國,自己在南方安心發展。可見魯肅雖善,但他也同時可以顧及自己,使雙方都能得益,這就是有大智慧及有遠見的智者,可說是最能體驗我心中善的靈魂人物。




